REMCOAI SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

REMCOAI may award 5 (five) \$1,000 scholarships.

On August 3, 2016 The Board of Directors of REMCOAI granted the scholarship committee the flexibility to award scholarships in the event that insufficient or incomplete applications are received, in a specific classification (High School graduating senior VS a continuing education student).

Scholarships will be granted to graduating high school seniors who will be entering an <u>accredited college</u> <u>or university, vocational/trade school</u> as a <u>full-time student.</u>

Scholarships will be granted to students continuing their education at an <u>accredited college</u>, <u>university</u> <u>or vocational/trade school</u> as a <u>full-time student</u>.

All applicants must be registered and attend as full-time students at the institution of attendance in order to be awarded a REMCOAI Scholarship check.

Applicants must have maintained a minimum of a 3.0 grade point average in their courses, verified by a school Admissions Official. **Personal goals and current extra-curricular activities** will be heavily considered in the scoring process and need to be updated as you pursue your educational goals.

- Applicant must be the son, daughter, grandson, granddaughter, legally adopted children or grandchildren, or a dues paying member of REMCOAI.
- Applicants must meet all requirements set by the college, university or vocational/trade school
 of their choosing.
- No application will be accepted without the following documents:
 - The application form (all lines completed and signed where applicable)
 - Official signed Transcript of Records with school seal.
 - Two signed Letters of Recommendation from a school official, teacher, or other identified professional person. Letters of recommendation need to be updated as you pursue your educational goals.
 - A brief signed personal essay from applicant detailing applicant's education, professional goals, community service, sports, employment, and/or other personal activities.
- NOTE: All documents must be signed by applicant and reference letters must be signed by author.

All applications **must** be <u>received</u> no later than **MARCH 31, 2023** Any applications or other documentation received after this date will not be accepted or considered unless the Chairman has specifically requested said documentation.

Announcement of the winners will be announced by **JUNE 2023**. Payment of scholarships will be made, when a certificate of enrollment signed by the Registrar of your attending institution and affixed with the school seal is received by REMCOAI.
